Board Meeting Minutes April 11, 2016 6:30pm Sherman Oaks Community Center 1800A Fruitdale Ave San Jose CA 95128

- 1. Call to order at 6:40pm by President Layne Kulwin. Present: Marlene Bird, Randi Kinman, Michael LaRocca, Jussi Rajna, Lisa Steingart. Agenda adjusted.
- 2. Approval of Previous Minutes
 - a. No General Meeting Minutes for March 2016; no meeting

- a. Planning and Land use. No new projects, St. Elizabeth community meeting was already held. Marlene noted that the Fruitdale Station site now has local seamstress who moved from Bascom and is being leased.

- c. San Jose City College: Construction plan due to be approved by the board this week. Report will be given at general meeting.

- f. VMC: Randi and other neighborhood leaders met with VMC "task force" in March. Focus last month was on identifying problem sites or hot spots. Neighbors and businesses are focusing on the idea that we can't make people use available services, but their rights stop when they impede our rights to basic health and safety. Noted that SJPD or other agency cleaned out Rexford recently. Next meeting will concentrate on the numbers; people leaving AMA, the cost of transportation, who/how much, etc. Staff is now being hired for the one stop mobile team.
- 6. New Business
 - a. The homeless encampment at Moorpark/Menker has been an ongoing problem. Randi outlined complaint to Caltrans and local elected officials. This has been bumped up to Assembly Member Evan Low's office. Also outlined the other issues along Parkmoor/Bascom between Meridian and Bascom that are negatively impacting residents and impeding pedestrian access. Note: move this to ongoing projects until resolved. All correspondence will be added to the next board agenda.
 - b. KaBOOM! playground will be celebrating 1-year anniversary on May 14. Parks Foundation and CUSD are hosting celebration. Michael will pick up fruit snacks for distribution.
 - c. SONA will send condolence card to family of 20-year old John Kim who recently passed. John has been a youth leader in the KACS Christmas holiday program for years along with father James Kim.
