Neighborhood News

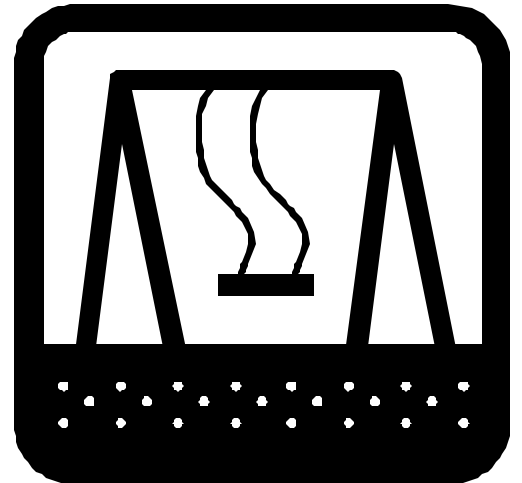
The realignment of the Parks Department has meant shuffling and moving staff around. San Jose City College has offered residents a great deal on accessing the SJCC library. Simply present your identification to the library staff and pay the nominal fee to obtain a library card. This allows you access to all the library facilities and equipment. This allows residents to access a library without having to make a journey to the downtown City library. Don't forget that the schedule for street sweeping changes at the first of the year. We will now go back to monthly street cleaning on the fourth Thursday of each month. This means you should move your vehicles into your driveway each month to allow access to the streets. New Park Dedication

The Buena Vista Park at the corner of Scott and Menker was formally dedicated on Saturday, December 13, 2003. Residents from the surrounding area, including SONA, were welcomed by Councilman Ken Yeager and Parks Director Sara Hensley. This park was built with funding from various sources on one residential lot. Though small in size, it boasts amenities that rival larger parks. With open space, picnic tables and a large pepper tree for shade, the park feels spacious. The central playground equipment includes slides, bridges, tunnels, a climbing wall and other activity stations that should keep the young ones busy for hours. There is even a low tech communication system that allows the kids to talk to each other through tubes across the park. Surrounded by a wrought iron fence that keeps children in and traffic out, this is truly a little gem that you should visit soon. The park has been officially adopted by the staff and residents of Amicus house. Kudos to the City Staff, Buena Vista N/A and the Burbank Del Monte NAC for moving this project along.
