The first public hearing on site development of the old **Del Monte Cannery site** will be on April 7 at 6:30 p.m. at the fire training facility on Montgomery between West San Carlos and Park Avenue. This is the first opportunity to see and comment on the design. During the EIR scoping meeting in March, residents from many neighborhoods expressed concern about traffic and safety issues, schools, historical preservation and the relationship of the property to the creek.

General Plan Amendment Hearings are being held throughout the city

during the next month to determine what changes are being proposed. This is your first opportunity to look at proposed zoning changes that could affect your neighborhood.

Burbank Del Monte NAC Grants Funds

At the March 25, 2004 meeting of the Burbank Del Monte Neighborhood Advisory Committee, **SONA was granted \$4,000.00 in funding requests.** The request submitted will allow us to supplement dumpsters, finance some newsletters and hold our **second National Night Out** event in August. This total represents an opportunity for us to hold events and bring our neighbors together for work and play. Our thanks to the Burbank Del Monte NAC.

The NAC also granted a funding request from the **Buena Vista Neighborhood Association totaling \$2,600.00.** They will use these funds to print the materials for their Historic Home Tour, hold national night out and spirit events and also celebrate the opening of the newest park in the area, the Buena Vista Park on Scott and Menker. The BVNA is directly across Hwy 280 from SONA.

In the most controversial decision of the evening, the NAC agreed to transfer funds for park acquisition to the **Richmond Menker** rehabilitation project. The request to transfer \$250,000.00 in funding will supplement the \$130,000 in city/owner funds along with the \$160,000 in loans the owners are assuming to complete this project. The additional money will help in landscaping and painting the apartments. Groundbreaking in Spring 2004.
