

Since 1984 communities around the world set aside this night to fight crime by getting to know their neighbors and lighting up the streets. Your participation can be as simple as turning on your porch light. Or, grab a couple of lawn chairs, a cooler of sodas and invite the neighbors over for a driveway or front yard chat. How many of you waive to those neighbors across the street but really don't know anything about them? How many times do you wonder if somebody close by can keep an eye on your house while you're gone or have a kid who can mow lawns or babysit? Do you worry about your elderly neighbors when you don't see them? Are you a senior who knows you're going to need help down the line? Would you like to get to know the new neighbors and welcome them or are you new to the neighborhood?

And how many times have you wondered how you can help make your neighborhood safer?

By taking one night to get together casually you can swap ideas, meet the neighbors and talk about what is important on your block. Your neighborhood becomes a safer place when people know who lives nearby and begin developing relationships.
