Traffic is always an ongoing problem with many streets experiencing cut through traffic and speeding. Combined with parking problems this creates a less than desirable situation for our local pedestrian traffic.

Jim Bittner from the Department of Transportation will be speaking at our April meeting to address many of the concerns brought out at our meeting and through the SONA surveys.

The new **branch library** will be on track now that the City has purchased the Murrays Bar site on Bascom Avenue. Our March meeting will include a presentation for the time line of this project. Plans for a full service **community center** on the old **K-Mart** site are still in the processing stage. PRNS has applied for a grant to underground parking for this facility.

Questions

Department of Transportation Update

Many of you have seen the radar trailer on Kingman Avenue in recent weeks and some mysterious black hoses at different intersections. These are helping the Department of Transportation (DOT) assess traffic in our area.

Our **April 2004** general meeting will bring staff from DOT to give us results of these studies and to answer questions. If you have traffic related questions, please forward them to any SONA board member. We'll pass them along to staff so we can have a meeting that includes answers and not just questions.

In addition, DOT will be painting **red curbs** in our neighborhood. Besides general maintenance, they will be painting some new areas. Neighbors have complained about cars parking in the small area between driveways that run side by side. These small areas are not large enough to accommodate cars without blocking part of the driveways. 
